 5. A 50% discount for BA admission fees is offered to the first 10 students

ADMISSION RULES:

GENERAL:

1. Admission fees are to be paid every semester.
2. Fees paid are non-refundable.
3. Any free concessions will be at the discretion of the Society.

MESS FEES:

1. Monthly mess fees must be paid on or before the 10th of each month. Failure to pay on time will incur a late fee of 10 rupees for each day of delay.
